**Minutes of the meeting of monitoring committee to oversee the pollution related matters  
held on 17.10.2024 at 3:00 pm through VC under the chairmanship of  
Member Secretary, Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC) at  
conference hall, Department of Industries, Sri Vijaya Puram for  
holistic development of Great Nicobar Island project.**

List of persons attended the meeting is enclosed at **Annexure -I.**

Member Secretary, ANPCC in his opening remarks welcomed the members of monitoring committee to oversee pollution related matters and measures & its implementation regarding holistic development of Great Nicobar Island project.

As decided in the last joint monitoring committee meeting held on 30.04.2024, the draft monitoring framework to oversee pollution related matter was submitted to all the committee members vide letter dated 25.09.2024.


Senior Consultant (Environmental Planner), ANIIDCO made a presentation briefing the background, key projects involved, status of the project, budget of Environmental Management plan & Environmental Monitoring program submitted to MoEF&CC vide letter dated 23.12.2023. The copy of the presentation is enclosed at **Annexure - II.**

The following issues were discussed:

1. Dr. Dipanjan Majumdar, Soil Pollution Expert suggested that landuse GIS maps, sampling points of soil, water & noise to be marked on GIS maps and to be shared with Committee members and also made suggestions regarding use of top soil, plan for treatment of sewage/waste water, etc.
2. Shri. Indranil Roy, Scientist from CGWB suggested to include the ground water baseline data & complete parameters of ground water quality and also made suggestions regarding number of sampling locations, additional parameters to be monitored, etc.
3. Prof. Anupam Debsarkar, Noise Expert suggested to include the maps showing the project boundary with its components and noise quality samples/ locations in the monitoring framework.
4. Shri. M. K. Biswas, CPCB representative suggested to detail out the status of monitoring framework in terms of parameters to be monitored & standards to be followed and suggested implementing agencies of all key projects to be part of upcoming meetings.
5. Dr. Gopala Krishna Darbha, Water Expert suggested that a clear map of the site of construction and the points for water sampling to be presented, made suggestions regarding monitoring of surface & ground water quality parameters.
6. Ms. Sandhya Yadav, Scientist from CGWB suggested to include the details of existing ground water quality monitoring locations and location map of proposed fresh water reservoirs and its status.

It was clarified by Chairman and GM (Projects), ANIIDCO that EIA study has been carried out which has been appraised by EAC and EC & CRZ Clearance has been granted by MoEF&CC. The role of the committee is to review the progress of work and implementation of mitigation measures and advice further on its implementation. Accordingly, Chairman requested all the members of the committee to share the comments on the draft monitoring framework which shall be reviewed and incorporated in the Environmental Monitoring Programme.


